

# Update 86: Bangalore, India - Reports Rise in Severe Acute Respiratory Infections Adding Further Challenges to COVID-19 Pandemic

- Doctors in several private hospitals in Bangalore, India have raised concerns over the increase in the number of Severe Acute Respiratory Infections (SARI)
- At least two hospitals including Manipal Hospitals and ACE Suhas Hospital in Jigani, South Bengaluru have reported an increase in the number of SARI cases
- Manipal Hospitals reported around 20 SARI cases while ACE Suhas Hospital said it had registered a 150 per cent rise in such cases
- SARI can add to the severity of COVID-19 infection in patients with a history of facing respiratory issues and other comorbidities
- The hospitals observed a 20 to 30 per cent increase in severe cases of SARI among kids in the past few days
- Dr Jagadish Hiremath of Suhas Hospital attributed the hike to climate and other people "lowering their guard"
- This is a season of a 'twindemic' with both flu and COVID-19 infections, as the respiratory viral season is underway till as late as April 2021
- A consultant at Manipal Hospitals said the increase in SARI cases might add a burden to the healthcare sector as the COVID-19 is still underway
- Proper measures need to be taken to prevent the new strain to cause a second wave of the pandemic to date, India has recorded 10,341,291 COVID-19 cases with 149,686 deaths, ~1.44% of total cases, and 9,946,867 recoveries, ~96.18% of total cases)
- When compared to the overall population of the country, confirmed COVID-19 cases and fatality rate stands at 0.74% and 0.01%, respectively

# Impact level Definitions

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	<b>Certain</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering prompt action. Examples of Immediate level alert events may include bankruptcy filings, data breaches, unexpected curfews, strikes, power black-outs, major geo-political events etc.
High	<b>Highly likely to occur in the near term (within 3 months)</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a state of readiness to take quick action. Examples of High level alert events may include withdrawal of rating by ratings agencies, hostile takeover, multiple cyber-attacks, new business policies causing significant hardship etc.
Medium	<b>Likely to occur in the mid-term (within 3 to 6 months)</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being ready to take proactive actions if and when situation deteriorates further. Examples of Medium level alert events may include unplanned C-level exits, suppliers caught in bribery cases, economy slipping into recession.
Low	<b>Possible in the long-term (after 6 months)</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve. Examples of Low level alert events may include lawsuits filed against suppliers, client losses, air pollution alerts issued by country's local authorities, unexpected holidays announced for the location etc.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a risk element associated with it. Examples of Info level alert events may include launch of new solutions, partnerships signed, industry outlook, positive changes in government policies, announcements regarding launch of software parks/ free trade zones/special economic zones etc.
