Update 61: Nanjing, China - Reports Surge in Delta Variant Cases

- Health authorities in China are on high alert as the country's major eastern city of Nanjing has reported an outbreak of COVID-19
 cases believed to be caused by the Delta variant
- The cases have been confirmed since July 20, 2021 among people who used an airport in the city in Jiangsu Province
- Officials say that, except for cases among people arriving from overseas, 39 were confirmed on July 25 and 31 cases on July 26 in the province
- National authorities say it is the first time since the end of January 2021 that the number of daily cases has topped 30 in the country, excluding asymptomatic infections or cases among people arriving from overseas
- The Nanjing outbreak has expanded to about 10 cities in five provinces, including Guangdong, Sichuan, and Liaoning provinces
- Nanjing city has been virtually sealed off and residents advised to stay indoors
- Health authorities are working to conduct PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) tests on all citizens in the city
- Other cities in Jiangsu province are also reinforcing their anti-pandemic measures
- Suzhou has set up 18 checking points at highways to check health status of drivers coming from Nanjing
- · Suzhou has also suspended all road passenger transportation, including buses and taxis, with Nanjing
- Nanjing is major communication and industrial center in China
- Major industries in Nanjing include electronics, software, petrochemicals, automobiles, and steel
- On July 27, China reported 55 new locally transmitted COVID-19 cases, including 48 in Jiangsu Province, three in Sichuan, and two each in Liaoning and Yunnan
- Also reported were 31 new imported cases, of which 16 were reported in Yunnan, three each in Fujian and Guangdong, two in Sichuan, and one each in Beijing, Tianjin, Shanghai, Shandong, Hubei, Shaanxi, and Gansu
- Reported COVID-19 stats for China:
 - 1. Confirmed Cases: 92,762
 - 2. Deaths: 4,636 (5.0%)
 - 3. Recoveries 87,264 (94.7 %)
 - 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 15,833,61,000
 - 5. Fully Vaccinated: 223,299,000 (15.9%)

Impact level Definitions

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	Certain - Supply Wisdom recommends considering prompt action. Examples of Immediate level alert events may include bankruptcy filings, data breaches, unexpected curfews, strikes, power black-outs, major geo-political events etc.
High	Highly likely to occur in the near term (within 3 months) - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a state of readiness to take quick action. Examples of High level alert events may include withdrawal of rating by ratings agencies, hostile takeover, multiple cyber-attacks, new business policies causing significant hardship etc.
Medium	Likely to occur in the mid-term (within 3 to 6 months) - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being ready to take proactive actions if and when situation deteriorates further. Examples of Medium level alert events may include unplanned C-level exits, suppliers caught in bribery cases, economy slipping into recession.
Low	Possible in the long-term (after 6 months) - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve. Examples of Low level alert events may include lawsuits filed against suppliers, client losses, air pollution alerts issued by country's local authorities, unexpected holidays announced for the location etc.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a risk element associated with it. Examples of Info level alert events may include launch of new solutions, partnerships signed, industry outlook, positive changes in government policies, announcements regarding launch of software parks/ free trade zones/special economic zones etc.
