

# Update 63: China - Reports Delta Variant COVID-19 Outbreak in Fujian Province and Chongqing

- On July 31, 2021, health authorities of China reported a COVID-19 outbreak in Fujian Province and Chongqing
- The National Health Commission reported 55 new COVID-19 cases
- It is reported that the new outbreak is caused by the Delta variant
- Earlier, Beijing and four other provinces reported an outbreak of the virus
- 200 cases in the country are linked to an outbreak in Jiangsu province, where nine officials from the cleaning sector at the international airport in Nanjing City tested positive for COVID-19
- The tourist city of Zhangjiajie, in Hunan province, where several infected people watched a play, has confined its 1.5 million people and closed tourist attractions
- In Beijing's Changping district, 41,000 people were confined after detecting two cases of local contagion
- Nanjing outbreak has been spread to 27 Chinese cities
- China's COVID-19 surge triggers new lockdown in the country
- Fujian is a province on the southeastern coast of China. It is bordered by Zhejiang to the north, Jiangxi to the west, Guangdong to the south, and the Taiwan Strait to the east
- It is one of the most culturally and linguistically diverse provinces in China
- Chongqing is a sprawling municipality at the confluence of the Yangtze and Jialing rivers in southwestern China
- Chongqing serves as a financial center of the Sichuan Basin and the upstream Yangtze. It is a major manufacturing and transportation center
- Reported COVID-19 stats for China:
  1. Confirmed Cases: 92,930
  2. Deaths: 4,636 (4.99%)
  3. Recoveries: 87,323 (93.97%)
  4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 1,619,218,000
  5. Fully Vaccinated: 223,299,000 (15.9%)

# Impact level Definitions

| Impact Level  | Definitions                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                      |
|---------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Immediate     | <b>Certain</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering prompt action. Examples of Immediate level alert events may include bankruptcy filings, data breaches, unexpected curfews, strikes, power black-outs, major geo-political events etc.                                                                                                                      |
| High          | <b>Highly likely to occur in the near term (within 3 months)</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a state of readiness to take quick action. Examples of High level alert events may include withdrawal of rating by ratings agencies, hostile takeover, multiple cyber-attacks, new business policies causing significant hardship etc.                      |
| Medium        | <b>Likely to occur in the mid-term (within 3 to 6 months)</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being ready to take proactive actions if and when situation deteriorates further. Examples of Medium level alert events may include unplanned C-level exits, suppliers caught in bribery cases, economy slipping into recession. |
| Low           | <b>Possible in the long-term (after 6 months)</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve. Examples of Low level alert events may include lawsuits filed against suppliers, client losses, air pollution alerts issued by country's local authorities, unexpected holidays announced for the location etc.              |
| Informational | The event is pertinent information but does not have a risk element associated with it. Examples of Info level alert events may include launch of new solutions, partnerships signed, industry outlook, positive changes in government policies, announcements regarding launch of software parks/ free trade zones/special economic zones etc.                  |
