Update 96: Brisbane, Australia - Government Imposes Three Day Lockdown Amid Surge in Delta COVID-19 Variant Cases

- On July 30, 2021, Australian authorities have imposed a three-day lockdown in south-eastern parts of Queensland, including Brisbane
- Total 11 local government areas will go into a three-day lockdown
- The list of territories includes Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan, Moreton Bay, Redlands, Sunshine Coast, Gold Coast, Noosa, Somerset, Lockyer Valley, and Scenic Rim
- Residents under the lockdown can leave their homes for medical reasons, to buy essentials, such as groceries or medications, go to work or study if no alternative is available, and exercise within 10 kilometers radius of their home
- Lockdown was previously introduced in other parts of Australia due to outbreaks of COVID-19
- Authorities have imposed restrictions in Sydney, Victoria, New South Wales, South Australia, and other territories
- · Some people took to the streets to protest the decision
- Fewer than 15% of Australians are fully vaccinated against COVID-19
- Queensland officials reported six new COVID-19 cases in the last 24 hours
- Strict measures were imposed in Brisbane on a day just after authorities deployed hundreds of soldiers in Australia's largest city Sydney to enforce its COVID-19 lockdown
- Australia's federal government said the country would begin reopening and avoid snap lockdowns once 70% of the entire adult population has been fully vaccinated
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Australia:
  - 1. Confirmed Cases: 34,381
  - 2. Deaths: 924 (2.68%)
  - 3. Recoveries: 29,926 (87%)
  - 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 12,005,978
  - 5. Fully Vaccinated: 3,729,786 (14.5%)

# Impact level Definitions

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	Certain - Supply Wisdom recommends considering prompt action. Examples of Immediate level alert events may include bankruptcy filings, data breaches, unexpected curfews, strikes, power black-outs, major geo-political events etc.
High	Highly likely to occur in the near term (within 3 months) - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a state of readiness to take quick action. Examples of High level alert events may include withdrawal of rating by ratings agencies, hostile takeover, multiple cyber-attacks, new business policies causing significant hardship etc.
Medium	Likely to occur in the mid-term (within 3 to 6 months) - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being ready to take proactive actions if and when situation deteriorates further. Examples of Medium level alert events may include unplanned C-level exits, suppliers caught in bribery cases, economy slipping into recession.
Low	Possible in the long-term (after 6 months) - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve. Examples of Low level alert events may include lawsuits filed against suppliers, client losses, air pollution alerts issued by country's local authorities, unexpected holidays announced for the location etc.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a risk element associated with it. Examples of Info level alert events may include launch of new solutions, partnerships signed, industry outlook, positive changes in government policies, announcements regarding launch of software parks/ free trade zones/special economic zones etc.
